

Seed Quality

Resor Seeds is not just a local dealer; we are a local seed company. We make the decisions on what seed to sell based on our local testing and customer input.

We treat every bag of seed like we own it, because we do own it! That's why we strive to get returned corn back to our own cold storage as soon as possible. Most seed returns from customers are placed in our cold storage by late May before the weather turns hot.

We will also share our cold germination results with our customers, allowing them to use that information to make critical early planting decisions when we know the weather can turn cold quickly.

Most of our soybeans are grown in Illinois where typically higher humidity makes it easier to harvest seed beans at the proper moisture. This generally results in higher germination. We have tried to grow seed locally but have just had better luck with Illinois grown seed.

In 2020 most of our soybeans were tagged at 95% and none were tagged below 90%. Many growers are having success with lower soybean populations. Higher germ seed along with treated seed makes that decision easier.
